



But when it come to Joseph, there is nothing against him, just one little scratch, for the foundation must also be a masterpiece.




## 64-0705 - The Masterpiece

65 Now **the foundations is laid**, through faith, love, grace, and to perfection, through the patriarchs.



115 And he laid the wood on Isaac's shoulders. And **Isaac** went up the hill, led by **Abraham**. Beautiful type! **His only son**, taking him to the hill. And the very altar that he laid his son on, he packed it up the hill on his back. **A type of God sending His Son up Golgotha**, with a wooden cross on His back, the very cross He was nailed on, and where **"God spared not His Own Son."**






## Hebrews 5

<sup>8</sup> Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered;


<sup>9</sup> And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;



## Genesis 22:3-13 KJV



[4] Then **on the third day** Abraham lifted up his eyes, and saw the place afar off.




[5] And Abraham said unto his young men, Abide ye here with the ass; and I and the lad will go yonder and worship, and come again to you.


[8] And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.

39 And notice, he went **three-day's journey** and then he looked far off and he seen the mountain which he was to go to, to offer the... Isaac for a sacrifice. Now, a ordinary man can walk, anyhow, twenty-five a miles a day. I've walked thirty a many day. But ordinarily in th—those—these days when you go in your car everywhere you go, but them days they were used to walking. And if—if he went three-day's journey, **he was at least seventy five miles back.**



## 56-0614 - God Provided A Lamb

And then he looked and saw the mountain far off, probably another twenty-five miles. Now he's a hundred miles back from civilization.



He said; now to the servants he said, “You stay here.” Took the wood off the mule, laid it upon his son’s back (Beautiful type of Christ here at Calvary.), laid it upon Isaac’s back, which through Isaac... That’s Isaac’s obedience to death was the same as Christ obedient... And through Isaac was the seed of Abraham; through Isaac come Christ, and through Christ comes you and I by the Holy Spirit Who woos us to God,



56-0224 - Jehovah-Jireh

” gives us the same promise, the same hope, the same Life, the same Spirit; everything that they had, same children. We being dead in Christ, we take Abraham’s Seed and are heirs according to the promise. And look now in this type here.



## 56-0614 - God Provided A Lamb

I love this: Genesis 22. Fixing to close, listen close. Then when he come close to the mountain, he said to the servants... He took the wood, perfect type of Christ and God. He laid the wood on Isaac's shoulders, took the fire in his hand. And look at this now. Oh, I love this. Oh, He's wonderful. He said, "You stay here, **the lad and I are going yonder to worship. The lad and I shall return.**" Glory. I just had to let that come out. Look. How did he?



## 56-0614 - God Provided A Lamb


The Bible said that he had received him as one from the dead, knowed that God could raise him up from the dead. “How is he going to come back, Abraham? You’re going up to kill him. How’s he going to return with you?” But he took God’s Word, knowing that God had promised him, that through Isaac God was going to do something. He didn’t know what. But it wasn’t his business to know what. Just walk on.



## 56-0614 - God Provided A Lamb

Well it is... How's God going to heal me? I don't know, but walk on. "How am I going to tell my mother tonight that I got saved?" I can't tell you. "How am I going to tell my associates I received the Holy Spirit and born again?" I can't tell you. Walk on. Just keep going. Move on, laying aside everything, moving on towards Calvary.

28 Now, I used to think that God was angry with me, but Christ loved me. But come to find out that Christ is the very heart of God.

37 And in this Saviour He was wounded for our transgressions, because God loved you. And God saw the afflictions of His people, and with His stripes you were healed: God's grace making a way, for His love required it.



## 57-0126E - When Divine Love Is Projected

38 And when His love projected **His feeling**, Christ stepped out to take His place. It required something to take the place. His love alone went for you. And grace provided a sacrifice for you. Now, you're only to ask to believe it: "Whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." **Trusting that you catch the vision.**



## 63-0901E - Desperations

68 Now the Word plainly states, if you want to put this down, in Galatians 5:6, that, “Faith worketh by love.” See? “Faith worketh by love.” And the only way that you can have faith, is have love first. Because, after all, faith is love’s incentive. Incentive, that’s exactly what—what faith is. It’s an incentive to love. Now, you, if you don’t have love, you can’t have faith. See?

69 How can you have faith in your wife if you don't love her? That's in phileo. Now how about in agapao, to God? How can it be if you don't love God?

“ If you said you loved your wife, and never tell her about it, and never set down and make love to her, expressed it to her, kiss her, hug her, and tell her she's the best cook in the country, all the things that you know, and how pretty she is, and how much you love her; if you don't do that, she'll never know it.




## 63-0901E - Desperations

That's the way. If you do love her, you express it.


70 That's the way we do to God. When we love Him, we tell Him about it. We set down and we adore Him, and worship Him. And, see, love drives us to that.
